



HALO - Youth Specialist Internship

HALO is seeking four or five interns to support HALO youth in the Kansas City Learning Center and/or Kansas City Homes. Make an impact working with local homeless youth while using your own creativity! The HALO Youth Specialist Intern will primarily focus on working with HALO youth (ages range from 5 to lower 20's) who are either experiencing homelessness, living at HALO, or are at-risk and need additional resources.

This position will include some evening hours and weekends. HALO is located near the Chiefs Stadium in Kansas City, MO.

The intern's responsibilities could include any of the following depending on your placement either in the Learning Center or in the Homes:

- Collaborating with volunteers & Programs team to plan, prepare and facilitate professional development and therapeutic art workshops every week.
- Spending time in the office working on developing programming based on needs of youth and/or partnering shelters as they are identified.
- Administering program surveys to youth to assess program effectiveness on a quarterly basis.
- Meet individually with youth to help provide resources, programs and services for their immediate needs surrounding the areas of housing, healing or education.
- Assist Programs team on local outreach research and needs to expand the reach for HALO in Kansas City and surrounding communities.
- Gather and create marketing materials for the Learning Center and Homes.
- Assisting with special internal events for youth.
- Transporting youth to and from appointments, work, and school

This intern will report to Corey Pittman, HALO Learning Center Program Manager or Eliza Nelson, HALO Senior Youth Advocate.
